Scissors


String: wind 15'-20' light weight cotton upholstry thread on a cardboard about

2" x 4" (experiment with different types of string, light weight is best!)

Kite tail: 6 strips 1/4" x 11" joined together to make 2 tails appox. 32" long








Markers or color pencils for decorating kite Ruler (optional)










Use a sewing needle to poke a hole at mark and thread string through hole.

Flip kite over and tape string to back side of kite.






Refold kite as shown to form a keel down the center of kite.


