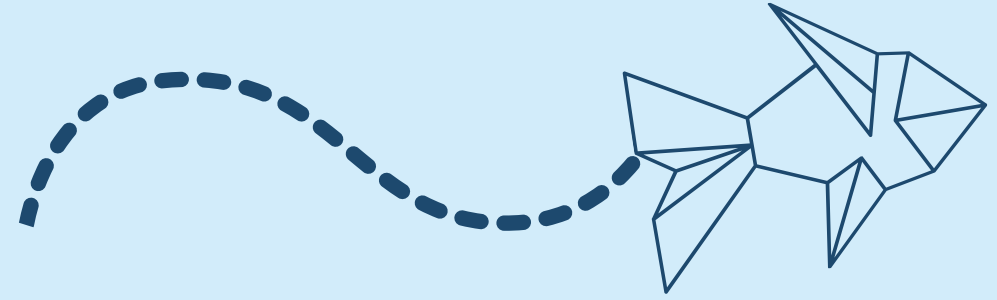
# Build a Salmon Kite

## Materials

Salmon sail 8.5 x 11 print out

Scissors

String: wind 15'-20' light weight cotton upholstery thread on a cardboard about

2" x 4" (experiment with different types of string, light weight is best!)

Sewing needle

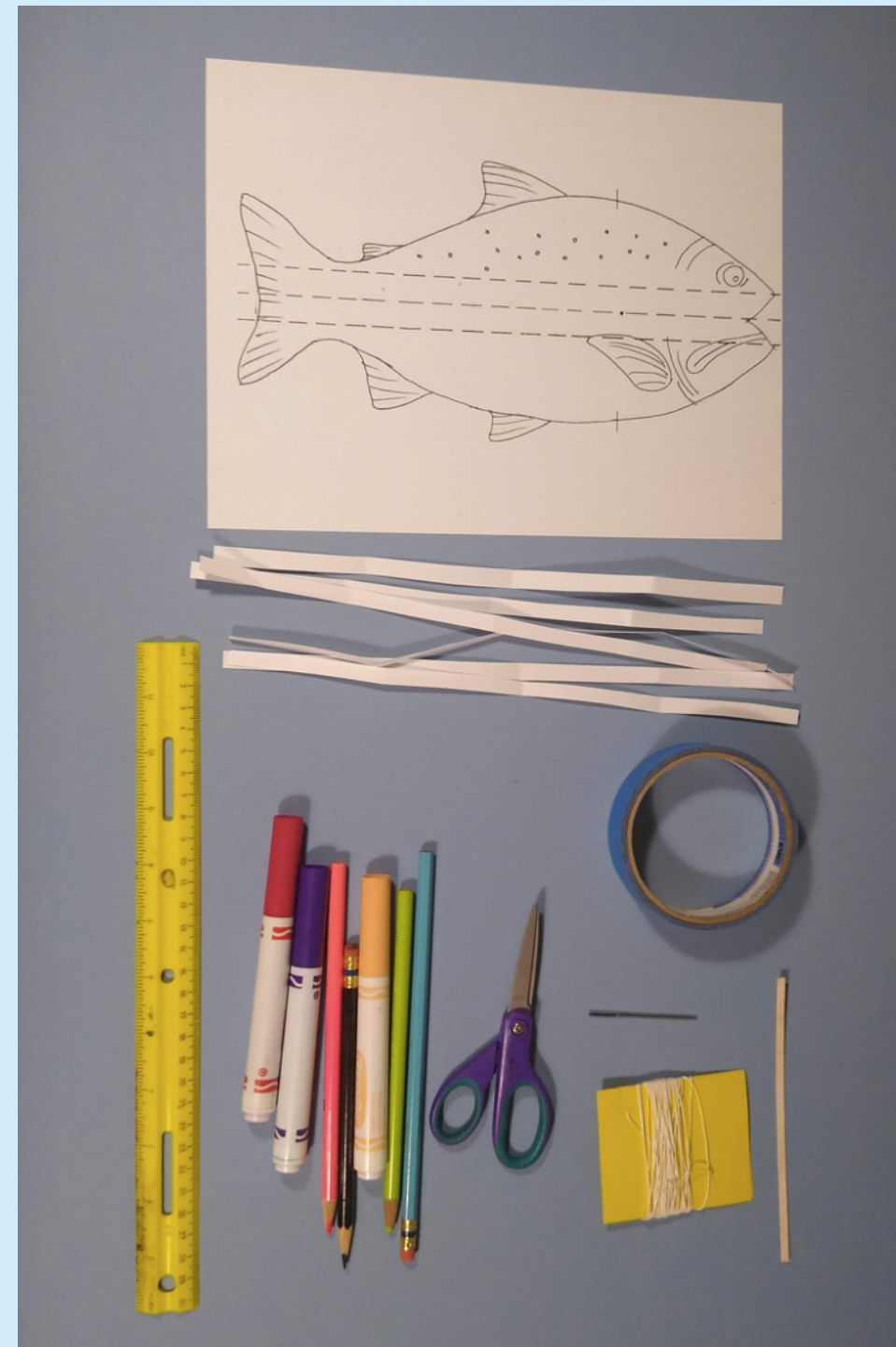
Tape

Kite tail: 6 strips 1/4" x 11" joined together to make 2 tails approx. 32" long

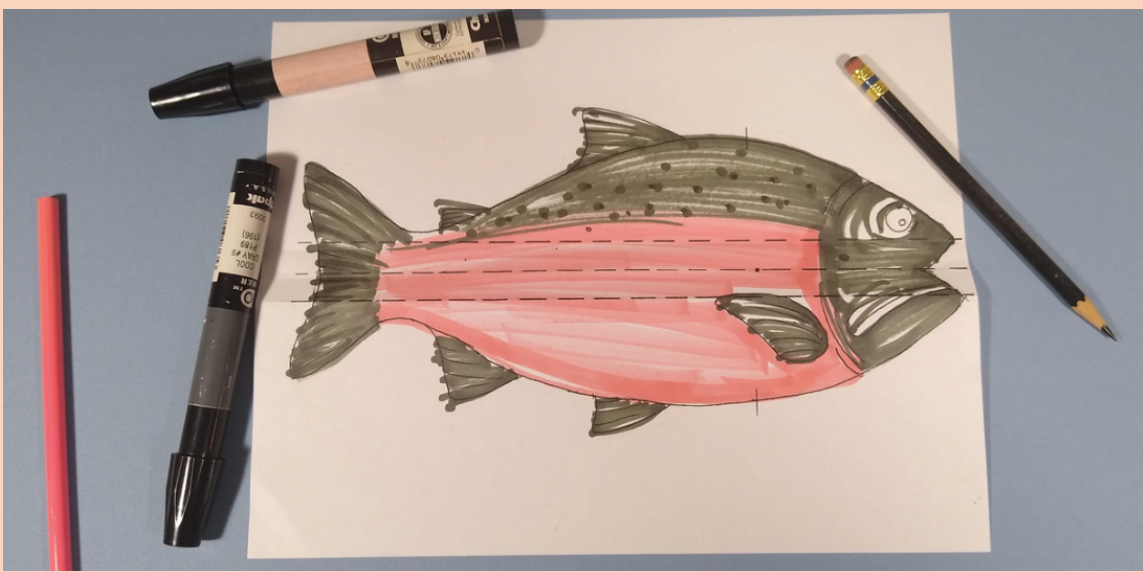
(add more if it is a gusty day)

Coffee stir stick

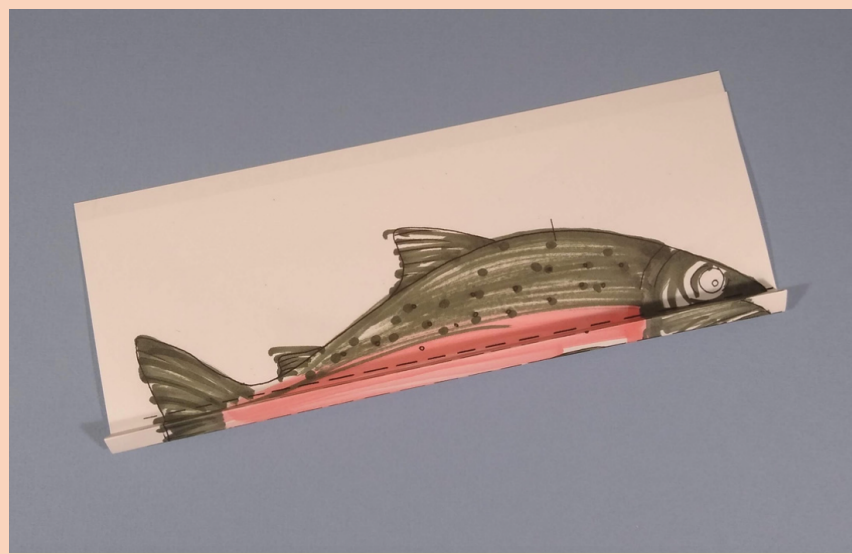
Markers or color pencils for decorating kite Ruler (optional)



1. Print out and decorate kite.



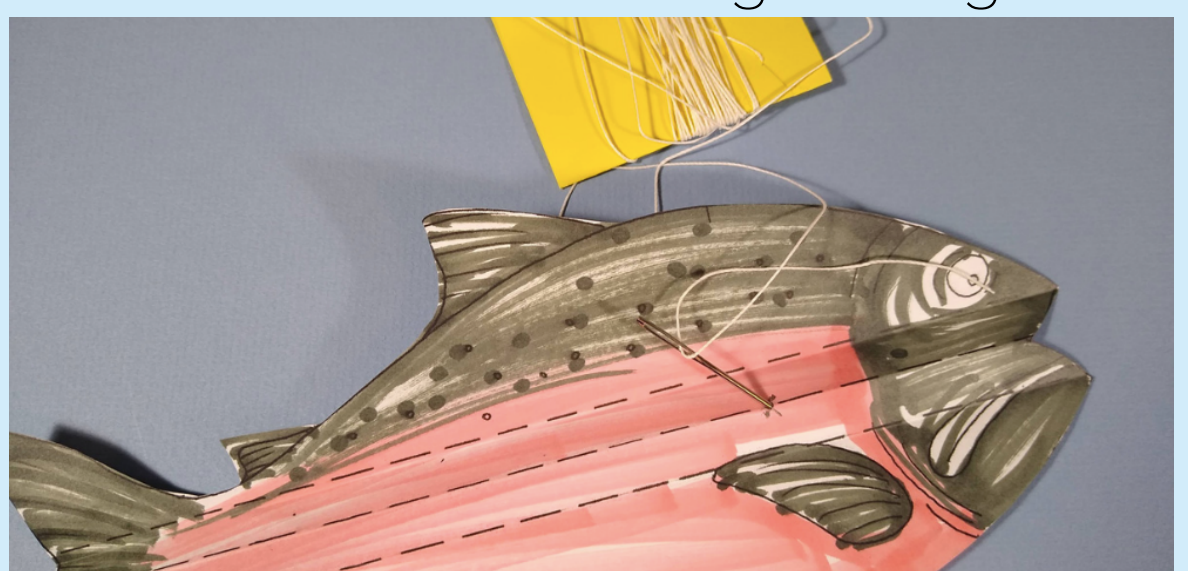
2. Fold kite on dotted lines, then unfold it.

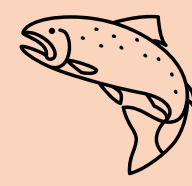
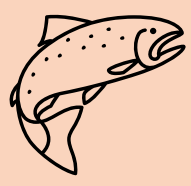


3. Cut the outline of the kite.



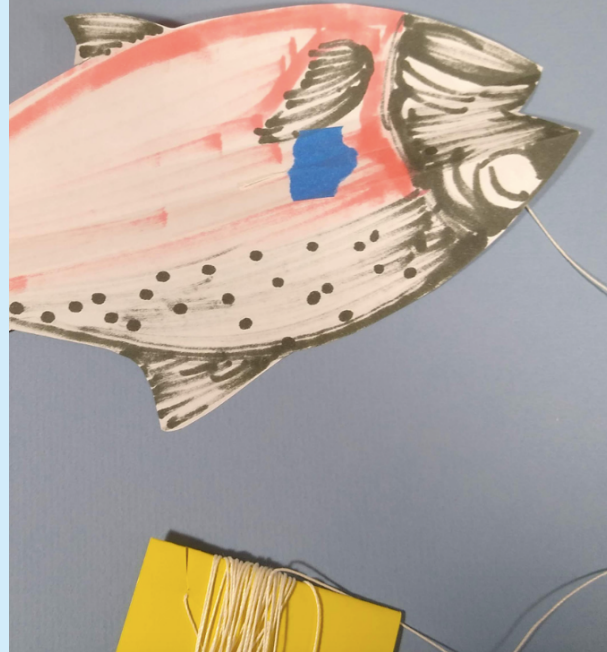
4. Use a sewing needle to poke a hole at mark and thread string through hole.



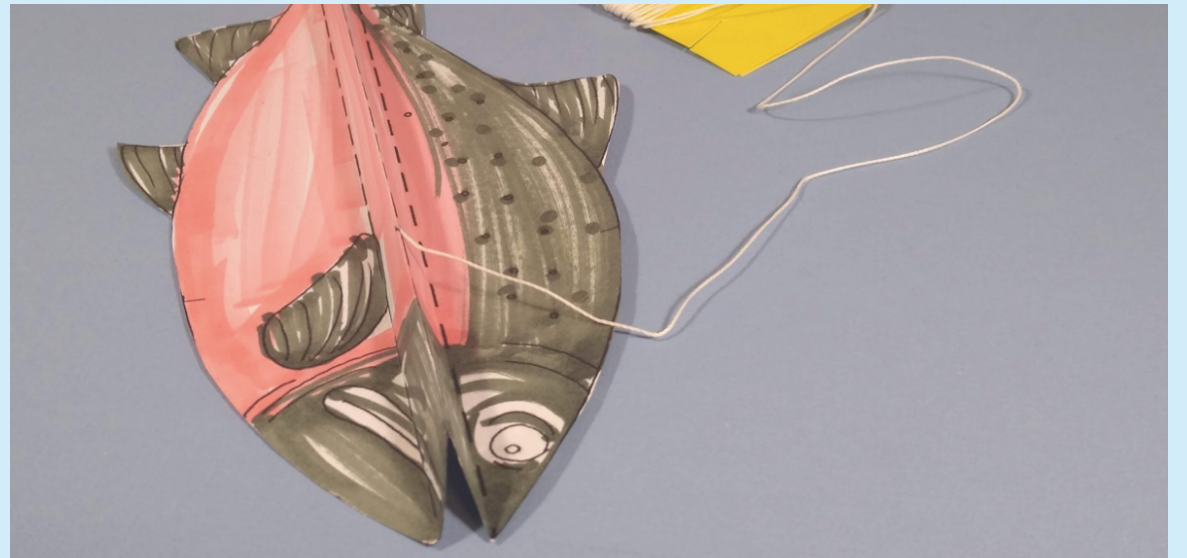


# Build a Salmon Kite

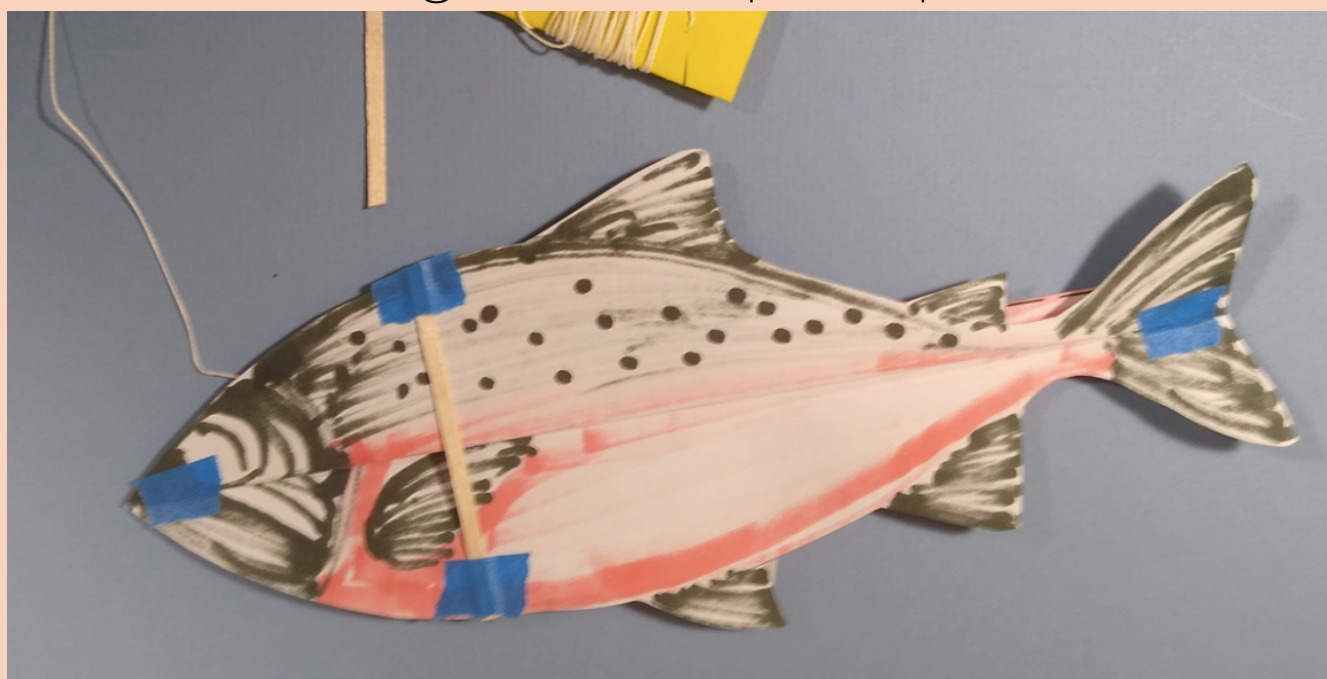
**5.** Flip kite over and tape string to back side of kite.



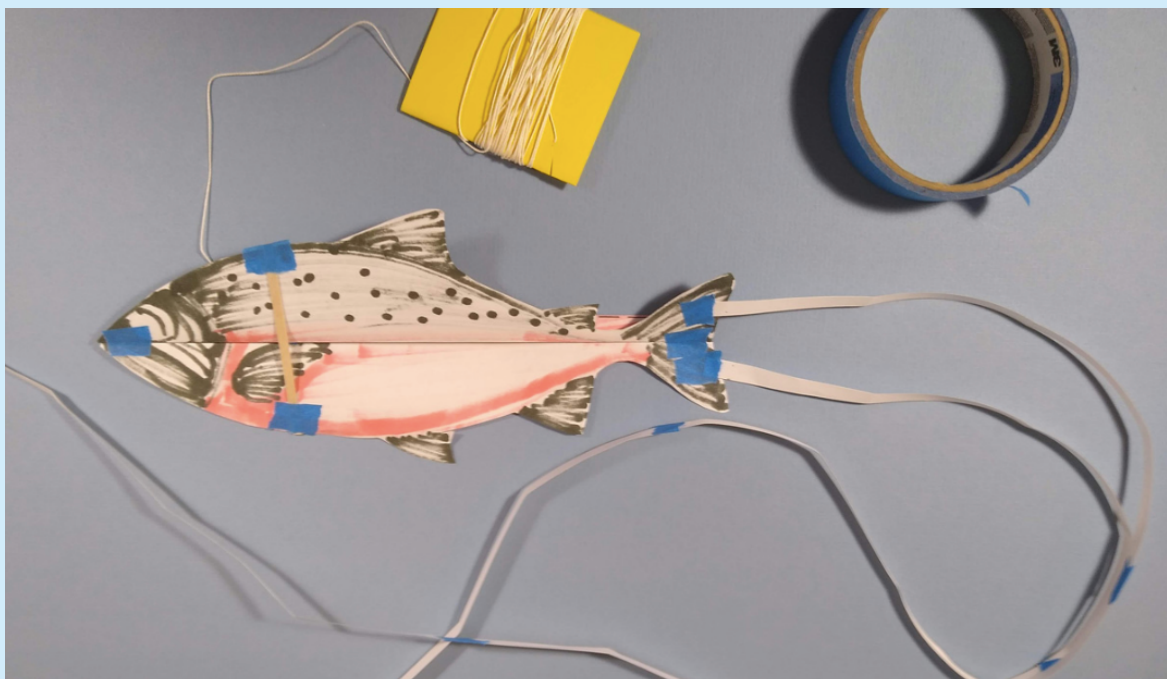
**6.** Refold kite as shown to form a keel down the center of kite.



**7.** Flip kite over and tape stir stick on back side of kite as shown. Cut excess stick length and tape top and bottom of kite.



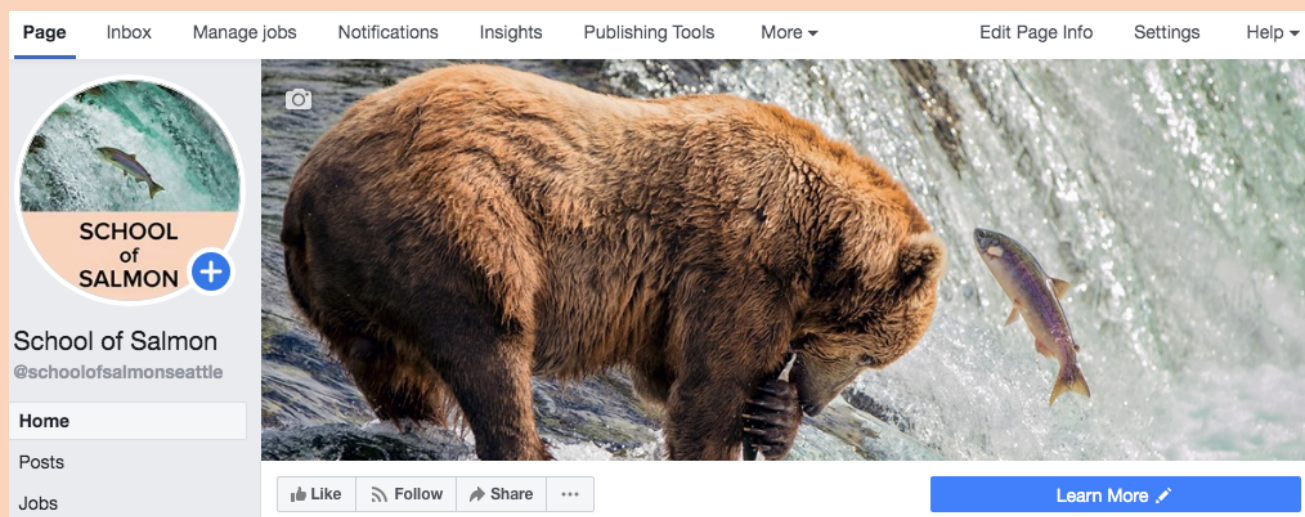
**8.** Tape tails to the bottom of kite.



**9.** Congratulations, your kite is now complete and ready to fly!
